We acknowledge receipt of the State of Mississippi's May 29, 2009, Amendment of the Neighborhood Stabilization Program as a Substantial Amendment to the 2008 Consolidated One-Year Action Plan for Housing and Community Development that was received in this office on June 2, 2009.

Our review revealed the following:

1. An increase of \$15,000,000 for the Homebuyer Assistance Program, NSP Activity Number 1, for a total activity budget of \$23,000,000;
2. The elimination of the \$20,000.00 Lease-Purchase Program, NSP Activity Number 2;
3. An increase of \$5,000,000 for the Jackson Housing Program, NSP Activity Number 3, for a total activity budget of \$16,000,000; and
4. The State complied with the mandatory 15-day comment period by making available the Substantially Amended NSP 2008 One-Year Action Plan from May 13, 2009, through May 28, 2009, in the Jackson Clarion Ledger, and on the Mississippi Development Authority website.

The State of Mississippi's May 29, 2009, Amendment of the Neighborhood Stabilization Program as a Substantial Amendment to the 2008 Consolidated One-Year Action Plan for Housing and Community Development is approved.
