Southeastern United States-
Canadian Provinces Alliance

The Southeastern United States-Canadian Provinces Alliance (SEUS-Canada) was established in November 2007 to promote continued trade and investment between member states of the Southeast United States (Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina and Tennessee) and member provinces from Canada (Manitoba, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Prince Edward Island and Quebec).

The goals of the Alliance are to present opportunities for businesses to enhance commercial exchanges, promote two-way investment, and encourage technological and scientific exchanges between and among the States and Provinces. Mississippi's specific goal is to promote the export of Mississippi goods to Canada, while encouraging Canadian investment to Mississippi.

The Newfoundland and Labrador Conference will focus on industry topics with links between the Southeast United States and Canada, including: Advanced Manufacturing, Energy, Ocean Technology and Economic Development. The Mississippi Development Authority, the state's leading economic development agency, will lead the Mississippi delegation.
