SUBJECT: CDBG Public Facility Application Deadline Dues Dates Revised

Purpose: The purpose of this Policy Statement is to announce revised dates and deadlines for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Facility applications for the 2020 allocation year.

Discussion: Due to the interruptions caused by COVID-19, and in an effort to assist our local units of government, the Mississippi Development Authority has revised the CDBG Public Facilities application and related deadline due dates. MDA has extended the three related due dates by approximately two months. All other application processes and procedures will remain unchanged.

In order to expedite the application review, rating and award processes, MDA urges all applicants to submit the applications as soon as possible ahead of the deadline date. MDA will review the applications as they are received.

Please pay close attention to all revised dates listed below:

DATE	DESCRIPTION
May 22, 2020	Water Viabilities Due for Public Facilities Water Applications
June 12, 2020	CDBG Closeout Packages Due*
July 17, 2020	CDBG Public Facilities Applications Due **

* Acceptable close-out packages required for the CDBG Public Facilities category are due by 4:00 p.m. on **June 12, 2020**. The information submitted for close-out packages must be complete and correct. Incomplete or incorrect close-out packages will be returned to the recipient for completion. Close-out packages submitted after **June 12, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.**, will cause applications to not be eligible for the 2020 CDBG Public Facilities funding round. This will not apply to applicants that have not been funded.

** Final submission for 2020 Public Facilities application is **July 17, 2020, at 4 p.m.** by MDA's clock. All matching funds must be in place and documented in the application by the final submission date of **July 17, 2020**.

Action: Local units of government and other interested parties are urged to carefully review the revised due dates and deadlines for the 2020 CDBG Public Facility Program.
